

## Permanent Closure – Jabuk and Yumali Waste Transfer Stations

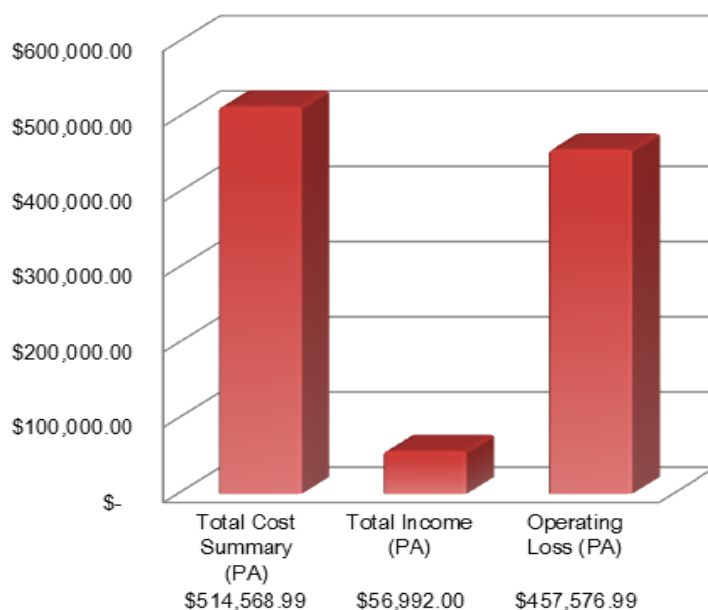
*Coorong District Council advises all users of the Jabuk and Yumali Waste Transfer Station (WTS) that they will be permanently closed from 19 March 2017.*

Council undertook a review of the Waste Transfer Station (WTS) due to the significant operational costs associated with the service. As part of the review, Council assessed the use of each site and the costs involved for providing these services. Council are operating at a loss of close to \$460k, highlighting the need to change the operation in order to reduce costs.

In the last financial year, Council had a total of 12 users attend across the two sites, with Jabuk receiving 3 users and Yumali 9 users, clearly highlighting that these sites are considerably underutilised making it difficult for Council to justify their continued operation.

Waste management is important to the Coorong District Council and remains a key strategic focus. Council will continue reviewing all WTS services to ensure that there is value for money for all ratepayers.

## **Dump Vouchers**

Dump Vouchers are available to rural rate payers of Council who do not reside within the township collection boundary and can be used at the abovementioned sites.

## OTHER WASTE COLLECTION OPTIONS

For residents outside the township area, Council provides either an en-route collection (for those with access to their properties along the existing collection route) or a bin bank collection.

This service provides a weekly 140 litre waste collection, a fortnightly 240 litre green organics collection and on the alternate fortnight provides a collection for the 240 litre recycling bin.

- 140 litre red lid waste bin (owned and maintained by resident)
- 240 litre yellow lid recycling bin (owned and maintained by Council)
- 240 litre green lid organics bin (owned and maintained by Council)
